Jumbo Flagstone

Our jumbo flagstone is quarried in large, natural slabs, suited to patios, walkways and paving where scale and natural character matter most. Each piece is selected for its shape and finish.

01 Planning & Consultation

Every project starts with a conversation about what you need — material, quantities, sizing and timeline.

02 Quote & Scheduling

A clear quote covering material and delivery, scheduled around your project timeline.

03 Quarrying & Cutting

Raw limestone is quarried, cut and finished to size on our own site on Manitoulin Island.

04 Delivery & Site Support

Finished stone is coordinated for delivery to your project site, big or small.

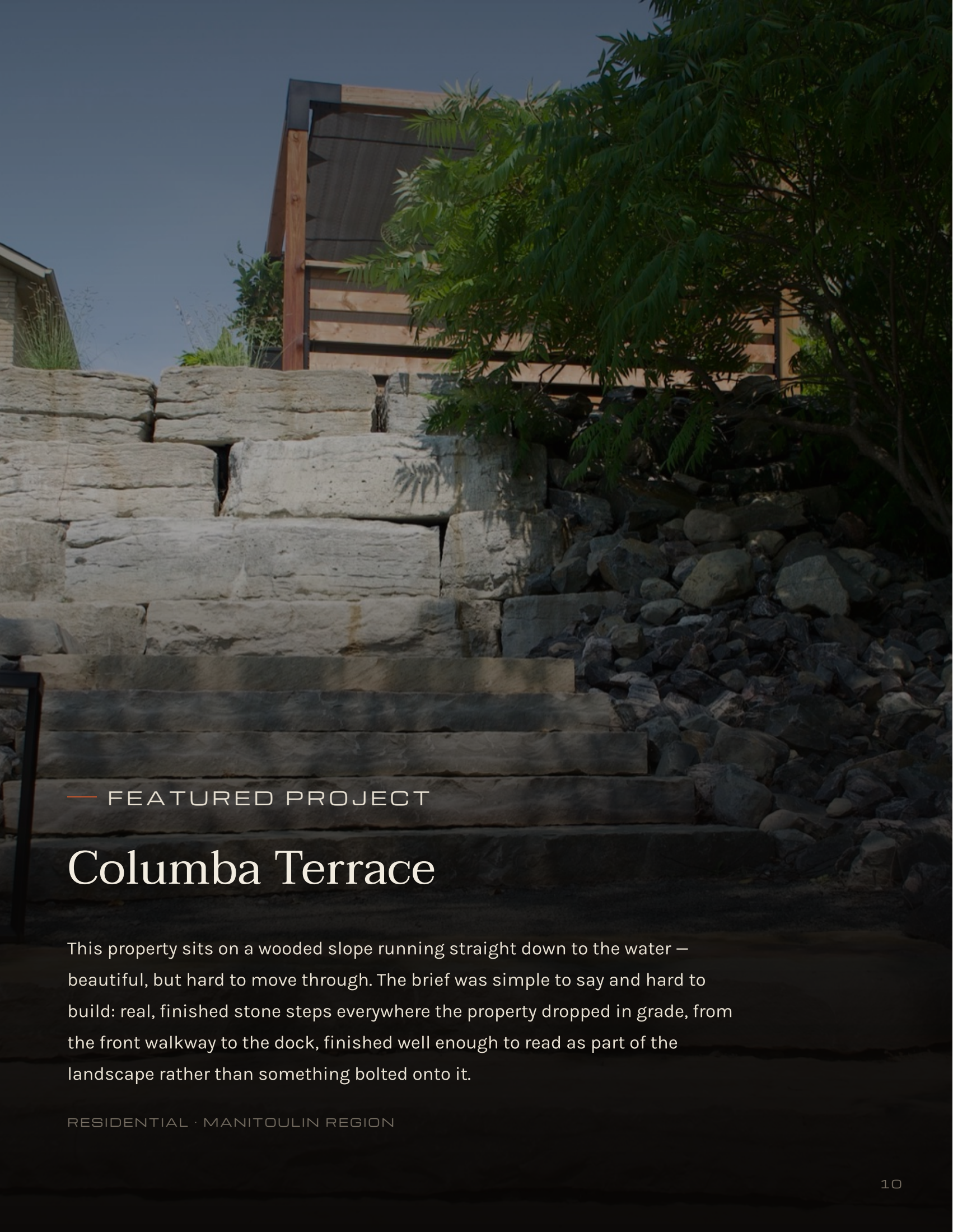

— FEATURED PROJECT

Columba Terrace

This property sits on a wooded slope running straight down to the water — beautiful, but hard to move through. The brief was simple to say and hard to build: real, finished stone steps everywhere the property dropped in grade, from the front walkway to the dock, finished well enough to read as part of the landscape rather than something bolted onto it.

— THE STAIRCASE

Built Into The Hill, Not Onto It

Large-format stone treads are set directly into the grade, with retaining walls built up on either side to hold the slope back and keep the run consistent from top to bottom. Each course is hand-fitted rather than dropped in evenly, so the staircase follows the natural curve of the hill instead of forcing it straight.



— FEATURED PROJECT

Nepawassi Lake

A new build on Nepawassi Lake needed more than a lawn between the house and the water. The scope covered the whole property: stone to hold the shoreline, stone to get down the grade from the house, and stone to build the gathering space that ties it all together.

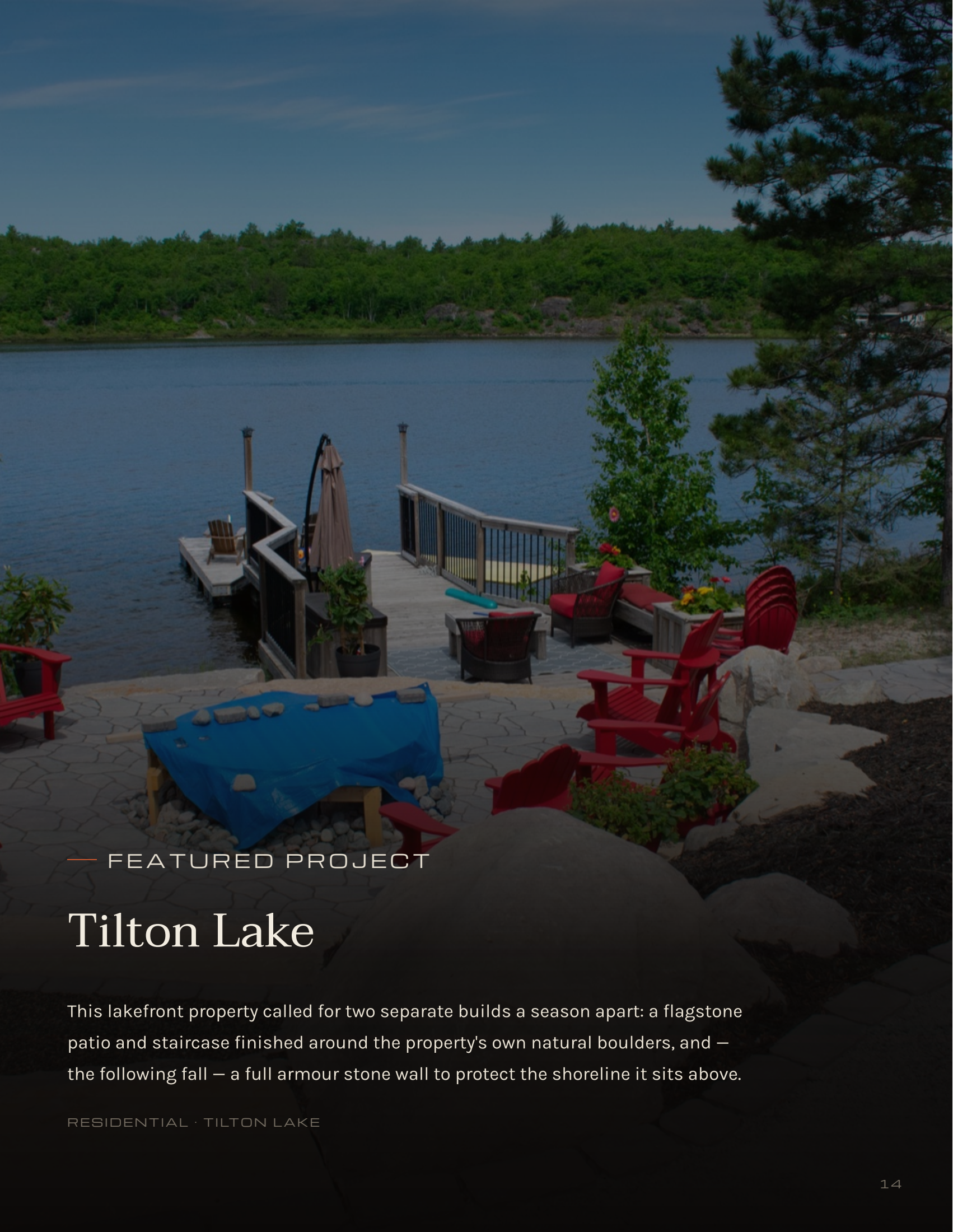

— THE SHORELINE

Holding The Water Back

Large armour stone sits directly at the waterline, set low and heavy enough to stay put through ice and wave action. It's placed to look like it belongs there — a natural extension of the shoreline rather than a visible wall built against it.



— FEATURED PROJECT

Tilton Lake

This lakefront property called for two separate builds a season apart: a flagstone patio and staircase finished around the property's own natural boulders, and — the following fall — a full armour stone wall to protect the shoreline it sits above.

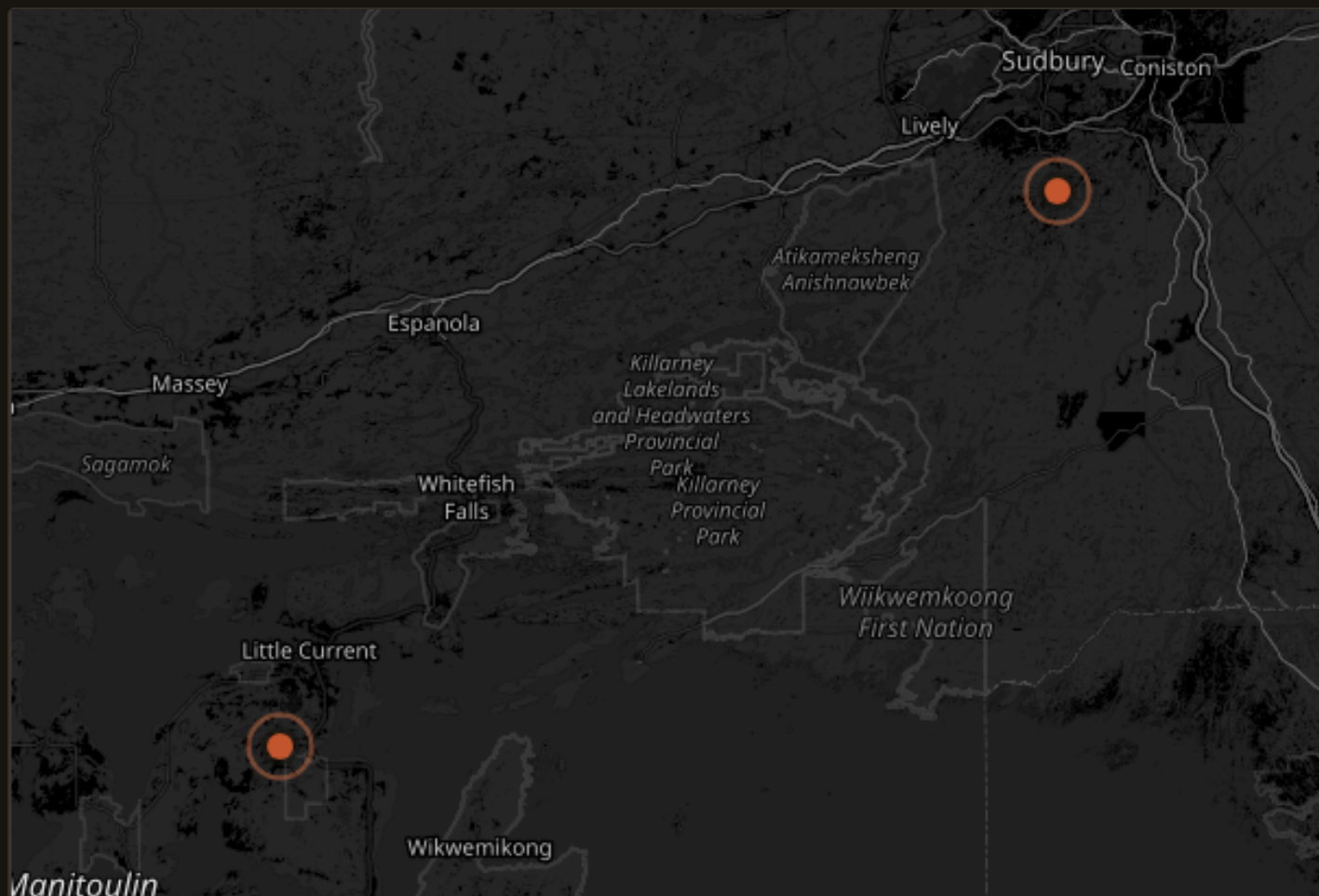


— THE SHORELINE

Built To Hold, Not Just To Look Right

The following fall, work moved down to the water. Large armour stone was staged on site and set directly along the shoreline — sized and placed to stay put through ice and seasonal water changes, not just for the first winter.
